These two facts about Jim and Teresa relate information about them, but there is much more to know about this active, interesting, involved, busy, loving couple. For one thing, while the majority of the residents at Baptist Village are completely retired (whatever that means), both Teresa and Jim work part-time at jobs within the larger community of Oklahoma City. Teresa works at The Children's Center Rehabilitation Hospital, and Jim works at a local department store.

The Children's hospital cares for and ministers to those children who have a wide variety of physical and/or mental challenges. Jim works in a department store helping men who live with some challenges of their own. Both of these jobs offer opportunities for Teresa and Jim to live out their strong commitment toward serving and loving others. That commitment has grown out of their underlying belief that God loves them deeply and unconditionally and calls them to love all people with whom they come in contact.

Jim commented, "I grew up in a Christian family and have adopted the values learned there as my life values." Studying at Tennessee Temple University helped solidify some of those beliefs and values. He pastored a church for eight years and actively supports and works with his local church here in Oklahoma City by teaching Bible study there as Teresa does also.

Teresa and Jim are parents of four adult children and 13 grandchildren. One of their grandchildren recently married. Jim was humbly proud of the fact that all of their children, as well as their grandchildren, are actively engaged in serving God as the pivot point of their lives. Music plays a big part in their daily lives. Singing together and playing a piano as the family gathers to enjoy traditional Christian music is one of their favorite activities. They noted songs such as, "Jesus Loves Me," and "It Is Well with My Soul" and other favorites that many of us claim as part of our church worship experiences.

Teresa and Jim have been residents at Baptist Village about a year and express joy and appreciation for this place. They enjoy the "community atmosphere" and the acceptance they experience here. Teresa and Jim Keeton do not have a lot time for getting bored. But they will always have time for new friends.


